Civil Legal Fellowship Program.

- Increase the amount of civil legal services available in Illinois by providing efficient and effective civil legal services by qualified lawyers and law students under their supervision.
- Develop additional legal, interpersonal, professional, and business skills to enable the clinic participants to obtain marketable legal skills and aid in their full-time employment after law school.
- Help the participating law students develop professional networking skills and to establish their own professional network.
